#### **Programs**

We have offered 323 program activities to 4,390 people. This includes 50 Salsa/Tai Chi classes, 150 neighbourhood walks, 25 crib nights, 48 rink sessions with attendants, 30 garden plots, and 20 outings of the Ice Cream Cart in the summer

#### **Events**

Park.

#### **Volunteers**


