**News - Recycling E Waste**

Why should you recycle E-waste? E-waste is a hazardous material, can leak toxic elements like mercury and lead, and can be harmful to the environment and to humans. Tossing device batteries in the garbage can cause fires at material recycling facilities. Ensuring your electronics are being reused or recycled at safely managed sites helps control the hazards. Recycling can allow for reliable resources found in electronics - recyclable plastics and gold - to be reclaimed. Accepted items at eco-stations include those on the right-hand side:

Accepted Items	
Item	Examples
Small appliances	Fans, rice cookers, coffee makers, toasters, hair dryers and similar items
Large appliances	Stoves, dishwashers, washing machines and similar items Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers and water coolers - \$21 per item for refrigerant (CFC) removal
Electronics	Computers and computer components, televisions, cell phones, tablets, smartwatches, electronic toys, rechargeable and disposable vape devices and similar items
